Use of Money: Targeted to individuals/groups of learners:

- TA- Staffing- Increased staffing in EYFS/ TA full time for every year group
- To deliver targeted Interventions: FFT/ BRP/ELS/ WAT
- Training for Intervention in KS2; Reciprocal Reading
- Y2 and Y6- focussed intervention work with additional teacher support (weekly sessions from Jan 2016)
- EYFS: Speech and Language consultant commissioned for 1 year: 3 x ½ Terms

- ½ day a week SEN Advisory Service Teacher to support teachers, parents and pupils.
