

HOLY CROSS AND ALL SAINTS MONDAY MISSION

THIS WEEK'S WORD:

John 3:13-17

At that time: Jesus said to Nicodemus, 'No one has ascended into heaven except he who descended from heaven, the Son of Man. And as Moses lifted up the serpent in the wilderness, so must the Son of Man be lifted up, that whoever believes in him may have eternal life.

For God so loved the world, that he gave his only begotten Son, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have eternal life. For God did not send his Son into the world to condemn the world, but in order that the world might be saved through him.



REFLECT

In the Gospel, Jesus tells us that He would be "lifted up" on the Cross so that everyone who believes in Him will have eternal life.

At first, the Cross was a sign of pain and sadness. But because of Jesus, the Cross became the greatest sign of love in the whole world. On the Cross, Jesus showed us how much God loves us – so much that He gave us His only Son.

Our school is called Holy Cross, which is very special. The name reminds us every day that we belong to Jesus, and that we are called to share His love. Every time we see the Cross in our school, we can remember that Jesus is with us – in our learning, in our friendships, and in our kindness to others.

So today, let's think about how we can carry our own little crosses – like when we try hard with our work, when we forgive someone, or when we choose to be kind. Jesus promises to help us turn those moments into something good.

Thank You for showing us Your love on the Cross. Bless our school, Holy Cross, and help us to live as children of the Cross – kind, loving, and faithful to You.
